We do have a leash law but the definition of "dogs running at large" allows for the situation where the dog may not be on a leash but is at heel near a competent person and obedient to that person's command. I do not know about all of the other law's but I would say that service dogs are generally obedient and would therefore be allowed to go without a leash if their owner is nearby and can bring the dog to heel.
